Scope of Work for Technical Services under CLIN 3007 Task Order

HSCG23-09-J-ARP272

Survivors' Compartment Joinery and Stowage Modification on Hull 45602

1.0 Background:

The Government wishes to redesign three areas of the survivors' compartment in order to provide additional stowage behind the port survivors' seating area, prevent items from falling onto the air conditioning unit and into bilge areas, and provide accessible workspace behind the starboard survivor's seating areas.

2.0 Requirements: The Contractor shall make the following modifications to Hull 45602.

- 2.1 Survivors' Compartment: Provide an enclosed stowage area on the port side of the survivors' compartment behind the survivors' seating area. The purpose of the stowage area is to store items that are used infrequently.
 - 2.1.1 The enclosed stowage area shall extend from approximately one foot forward of frame 13 to ten inches aft of frame 12.
 - 2.1.2 The enclosed area shall provide no less than 5 cubic feet of additional stowage.
 - 2.1.3 The closure for the stowage area shall be a horizontal hatch with a minimum of two latches. Latches will not be lockable, and shall not be susceptible to accidental opening. The hatch shall be hinged outboard.
 - 2.1.4 The interior of the enclosed space shall be lined with lightweight perforated metal sheathing to protect the insulation.
- 2.2 Protective Coaming: Install a protective coaming for the HVAC/Duct Heater Makeup Air Inlet. The purpose of the coaming is to prevent loose items and debris from falling down into the space around the survivors' compartment air conditioning unit and the bilge.
 - 2.2.1 The Contractor shall install a one inch coaming around the opening for the survivors' compartment air conditioning unit and duct heater in the horizontal surface between the starboard survivors' compartment seating and the shell.
